<p>Turn OFF power source before installation</p> 	<p>1. Remove inset/lens from channel</p> 	<p>2. Place channel in desired position on ceiling and mark or score the fixture position</p> 
<p>3. Cut out hole in ceiling</p>  <p>WARNING: Please note it's not recommended to make a ceiling cutout in the absence of the light fixture or a template</p>	<p>4. Thread conduit through top of channel (conduit supplied by others)</p> 	<p>5. Insert channel to blocks through drywall</p> 
<p>5. Use spacer block to maintain channel width</p> 	<p>6. Secure the spacer blocks to the channel</p> 	<p>7. Apply drywall mesh tape between the channel and the drywall. Repeat for each additional channel</p> 
<p>8. Cover gaps and flange with spackle</p>  <p>!</p>	<p>9. Once dry, paint over spackle</p> 	<p>10. Make connections</p>






IMPORTANT: Cover must sit flush. If cover does not sit flush and is not fully engaged, it might fall. Due to changes in temperature, the acrylic can slightly shrink and expand. As long as they are installed correctly, the lighting fixtures are designed to accommodate those physical changes.




IMPORTANT: Quick connectors must be tucked in between drivers and open space in the fixture. Make sure quick connectors don't rest on the LED board.

Cover must be fully engaged. You will feel a physical feedback and hear a "click" noise to confirm that the cover is engaged.

EN Installation, commissioning and maintenance may only be performed by authorized and qualified personnel, taking into consideration these installation instructions and any standards and regulations applicable to the respective area of application. The electrical, mechanical and thermal suitability of the luminaire for the intended area of application must be ensured and the secure fastening of the luminaire after its installation must be controlled. Turn off supply voltage before replacing any lamps (if applicable) as well as before performing any other works on the luminaire (e.g. cleaning) and wait until luminaire and lamp have completely cooled off. Please refer to the installation notes of the lamp manufacturer when inserting, replacing and operating conventional lamps. Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the luminaire. To clean plastic components and reflectors, a standard pH neutral, alcohol-free, non-abrasive cleaning agent may also be used. Keep these installation instructions in a safe place as reference for any future maintenance works.

1. The lamp is not suitable for outdoor use.
2. The lamp may only be used with a safety guard.
3. Damaged protection glasses and covers have to be replaced immediately.
4. Corrosive chemical products must not be used as this may have a detrimental effect on the luminaire.
5. No liability is accepted for any subsequent change of the luminaire.
6. LEDs are high-quality electronic components! Please avoid touching by hand the LED light emitting surface while assembling or replacing parts and during maintenance work.
7. To avoid damage of the profile, unevenness on the wall or ceiling must be leveled out before assembling the profiles. While assembling the profiles, make sure they do not deform in order to guarantee their proper function.
8. The light source contained in this luminaire shall only be replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person.
9. The LED circuit must always be closed, before the converter is connected to the main power. XAL does not assume any liability for damages resulting from nonobservance of this rule.
10. Luminous flux and connected electrical load are subject to an initial tolerance of up to +/- 10%. Color temperature is subject to a tolerance of up to +/- 150 Kelvin from the nominal value.

FR Le montage et la maintenance peut être effectuer par spécialistes respectant les normes y règles valides. Assurer l'aptitude thermique, mécanique et électrique pour l'emploi prévu et assurer la fixation de la luminaire. Éteindre la tension avant de changer les lampes (si applicable) ou avant de réaliser travaux (p.ex nettoyage) à la luminaire. Attender jusqu'à ce que la luminaire et les lampes ont fréchit complètement.
